- 25% dwarf perennial ryegrass
- 35% slender creeping red fescue
- 20% smooth stalked meadow grass
- 20% chewings fescue

All the varieties used (please contact us for the current mixture) are named cultivars, highly rated by the STRI (Sports Turf Research Institute) for wear and disease tolerance, recovery and appearance.

Lindum Ryegreen – LT3

Features

- new Bargold ryegrass combines fine appearance with wear tolerance
- rewarding finish with regular cylinder mowing

Uses

- prestigious fine lawns

Sown mixture

- 30% fine leaved perennial ryegrass
- 50% slender creeping red fescue
- 20% chewings fescue

Rhizomatous Tall Fescue – RTF

Features

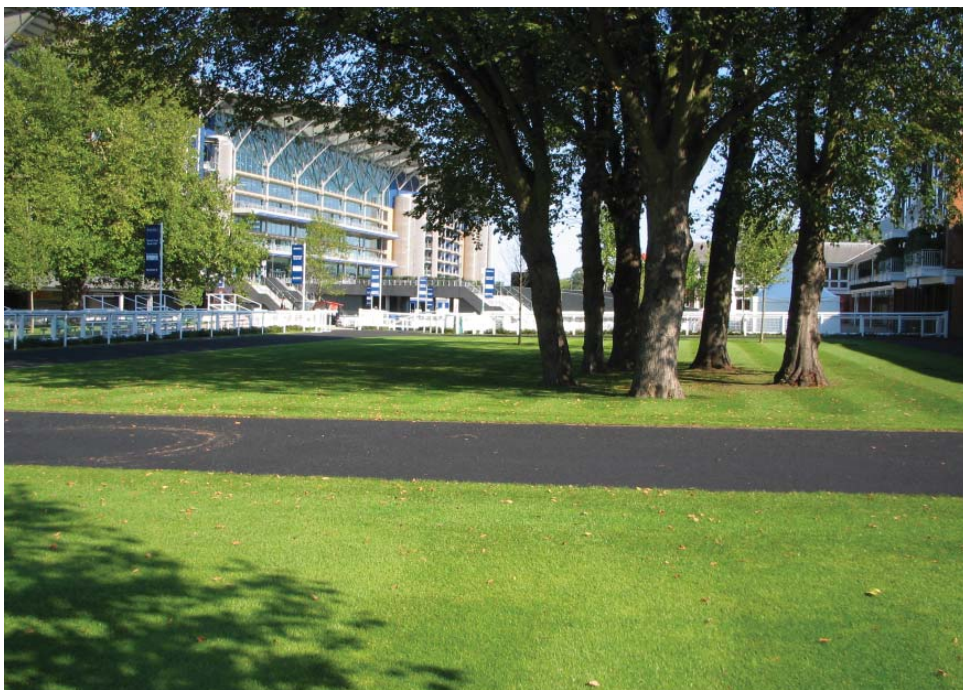
- deep rooting up to 1.5 metres
- produces rhizomes (underground stems) for repair of damaged areas
- drought tolerant (awarded prestigious Waterwise marque)

Uses

- lawns and areas subject to water restrictions
- soil stabilisation

Sown mixture

- 45% rhizomatous tall fescue
- 45% tall fescue
- 10% smooth stalked meadow grass

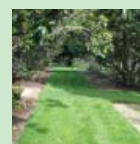


TURFING GUIDANCE NOTES

PREPARATION	Existing vegetation and stones should be removed and a light tilth prepared.
STORAGE	Turf is liable to deteriorate rapidly and should be laid within 24 hours of receipt. Please note all turf is harvested to order.
LAYING	Turfing shall comply with BS 3969 and be carried out when the weather and soil conditions are suitable. Turfing should not be carried out in exceptionally dry or frosty weather or when the ground is waterlogged.
AFTERCARE	Allowance should be made to keep the turf watered during dry periods encountered throughout the establishment period.
